Connected Forces Initiative



- Essential part of Chicago Summit Defence Package.
- To maintain (or increase) levels of interoperability as participation in operations (and pre deployment training) winds down.
- Shift from COIN operations in Afghanistan to a contingency posture in order to handle the whole spectrum of conflict.
- To ensure that Allies can communicate, practice together and certify their ability to do so through:
 - Expanded Education and Training.
 - Increased exercises.
 - Better use of technology.
